

# Feather Touch Brows - Microblading

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Eyebrow grooming in 2016 pretty much spans the entire spectrum. We pencil them, tint them, wax them, thread them, and even tattoo them. But just like permanent lip liner, inking your face isn't always the most natural looking option. And that's exactly why I am a fan of the super precise microblading technique.

The main difference is that instead of using a machine to fill brows, the procedure relies on a manual pen like tool that has tiny needles at the tip. After treating the skin with numbing cream the blade is dipped into cosmetic grade eyebrow pigment then individual strokes of pigment are placed into the brows. The result is subtly defined hair strokes - not a solid, filled look and lasts approx 18 months. A follow up visit is recommended after four weeks to fill any gaps and add a second colour for dimension.



This process eliminates bad surprises as first of all the shape is customised with a brow design drawn on in pencil so the client can see exactly what their finished shape will be. This ensures complete satisfaction with the finished result. Next the correct hue is matched to each clients natural brow hair and the shades are tested against the skin tone.

The whole procedure takes two hours (plus a follow-up appoint) and heals after a week.
